Please include the following information:

1. *How long has your nominee been active as a volunteer?*
2. *In what organizations has your volunteer been involved?*
3. *How has your nominee been active in encouraging others to become involved?*
4. *What is the most outstanding contribution your nominee has made as a volunteer?*
5. *Has your nominee been responsible for creating a new event, activity or conservation initiative?*
6. *Any other information that bolsters your nominee as a candidate for a BC Nature Award.*

The criteria for each BC Nature Award provides direction but the contribution that the nominee has made should be elaborated upon in your submission. Please keep the text to two or three paragraphs, about 600 words. Also please include a photo of the nominee at 300 DPI or greater.

If a member is nominating another member, please ensure that the club of the person being nominated is consulted to be sure there is no confusion or multiple nominations for the same award.

Note: Awards will only be presented at the BCN AGM meetings, no longer at Fall general meetings.

Please send your nomination(s) well before the deadline of March 18th as time is required to circulate nominations amongst the Awards Committee.
