

"To Know Nature and Keep it Worth Knowing"

2024 RENE SAVENYE SCHOLARSHIP

BC Nature will award one \$2,000 scholarship in the summer of 2024 to a student registered in fulltime studies towards an undergraduate degree or undergraduate diploma program at an accredited institution of higher learning in BC. The program must lead to a degree or diploma in a discipline which contributes to an awareness, appreciation and understanding of our natural environment.

Applications will be judged on the following criteria: Interest in nature and relevance of the academic program in which applicant is enrolled; transcript of marks showing sustained academic excellence in relevant subject areas; reference's evaluation of applicant; background in natural history, conservation and environmental issues and connection and involvement with nature through volunteer activities that promote "knowing nature and keeping nature worth knowing," by increasing awareness, appreciation and understanding of nature activities related to habitat conservation.

All scholarship applicants will be awarded a <u>one-year</u> direct membership to BC Nature and will receive a digital BC Nature magazine four times a year. With the membership, applicants are eligible to attend any BC Nature events, join committees and vote at general meetings. The scholarship will be awarded only once to a student; a previous award recipient will not be considered.
